



MAYFEST YOUNG ARTIST AWARDS 2019

Mayfest Young Artist Awards encourage the artistic and professional development of young students working in visual, performing, and literary arts. Five \$500 awards will be granted to high school students who attend school in Tulsa County. A panel of independent jurors will judge all applications. Winners will receive their award at the annual Harwelden Awards ceremony hosted by **ahha Tulsa** on Friday, March 8th, 2019.

ELIGIBILITY

Students currently in 9th-12th grades, who attend school in Tulsa County, and who can demonstrate the following in the visual, performing, or literary arts may apply:

- Artistic merit.
- Quality of craftsmanship.
- Clarity of purpose and goals.

RESTRICTIONS

- No more than one application per student per year may be submitted.
- Previous winners are not eligible to apply.
- The award money must be used within one year of receiving the funds.
- Winners must be present to receive their award at the Harwelden Awards ceremony on March 8th.
- Winners must have a current bank account in the United States.

AWARD REQUIREMENTS

The award money must be used for financial needs connected with artistic professional growth. This includes, but is not limited to, expenses for:

- Development of new work or completion of work in progress.



- Participation in workshops, classes, conferences, lessons, and other training.
- Production or portfolio costs.
- Materials and supplies.

APPLICATION PROCESS

Please fill out the online application form and include required support material in your submission. More application details are below.

Application Form:

Limit your responses to the short answer questions to 200 words or less.

Support Material:

- Submit one letter of support (from a teacher, mentor, etc.) that addresses your commitment to your artistic discipline.
- Submit samples of your work clearly and individually labeled with your first and last name according to the format(s) outlined below.
- Each student applicant may submit up to 10 works of art maximum across all disciplines. You are not required to submit 10 works of art.
- Your application is limited to 20MB total in uploads. Each upload must be 10MB or smaller.

FOLLOW SUBMISSION FORMATS EXACTLY AS STATED BELOW.

Submission Formats:

- Visual Art
 - 2D and 3D: Up to 10 photographs of original artwork. Files must be saved as JPEGs and titled Your First Name, Your Last Name, Number. For example, John Doe 1.



- Film and Video: Upload a direct link to Vimeo or YouTube ONLY. Total film/video run time must be 15 minutes or less. Include a PDF narrative sheet with title, date of work, and a brief description.

- Music, Theatre, & Dance
 - Audio and Video Recording: Upload a direct link to Vimeo or YouTube ONLY. Total run time must be 15 minutes or less. Include a PDF narrative sheet with title, date of work, and a brief description. Identify the applicant in the video, if necessary.

- Creative Writing
 - Writing: Writing sample(s) limited to 10 pages in PDF format. Include a cover sheet that includes the title of the work(s) and a brief description (not included in the 10 pages).
 - Performance: Authors who perform their work may also include a direct link to Vimeo or YouTube ONLY. Total run time of the audio recording or video must be 15 minutes or less. Include a PDF narrative sheet with title, date of work, and a brief description. Identify the applicant in the video, if necessary.
