Cat Puzzle Box

For this project you will need:

- A cardboard box
- Tape
- A sharpie
- A box knife
- Cat Toys- Tinkle balls work well
- Cat treats
- Cat nip if you got it :)
- Paint or markers to decorate with if you choose to decorate

1. Tape the top and bottom flaps of your box shut.
2. Using a sharpie draw windows and doors onto your box. You'll want them to be big enough for your cat's paw to slip through. We made our box into a "Mouse House" but you can decorate it how every you like.
3. Use a sharpie to draw where you'll cut the windows.
4. Cut on the window outlines with a box knife.
5. To create a door flap cut all but one side of the door. Bend the flap outward.
6. At this point, you can decorate with markers or paint.
7. Add your cat's favorite toys and treats and watch them go wild!

Stuffed Dog Toy

For this project you will need:

- Fabric, we used an old t shirt
- Needle & thread, or hot glue
- Stuffing, we use poly-fil but you could use old fabric scraps or yarn
- Yarn or ribbon
- Scissors
- Markers

1. Cut a rectangle from your fabric.
2. Using hot glue or needle and thread, attach the two long sides to each other to create a tube.
3. Stuff poly-fil or other filling into the middle of your toy. Leave about two inches on either end unstuffed.
4. Use two six inch pieces of yarn or ribbon to tie the ends of your toy shut.
5. Use markers to add a face or decoration to your toy.
